

**Career/Technical & Advanced ESL Certificate Programs
Eligible for Participation in 2025 Commencement**

Revised March 2025

The following programs are eligible for participation in Commencement 2025, to be held Friday, June 6, 2025 at the Spreckels Organ Pavilion in Balboa Park. Eligible students must:

- 1) Have completed the entire program by Fall 2024 or Spring 2025; **or**
- 2) Be 90% complete with the final course(s) for the program, with an expected final completion by June 7, 2025.

Remember: a PROGRAM is a combination of more than one COURSE in an academic area. For example:

Air Conditioning and Heating Program (120 hours) – complete two courses:

MECT 431: Air Conditioning/Heating I (72 hours)

MECT 432: Air Conditioning/Heating II (48 hours)

Culinary Arts Program (610 hours) – complete six courses:

FDNT 671: American Regional Cuisine (108 hours)

FDNT 672: Introduction to Principles of Cooking (108 hours)

FDNT 673: Principle of Meat & Seafood Fabrication & Cookery (108 hours)

FDNT 674: Intro to Vegetables, Starches, and Fruit (108 hours)

FDNT 675: Baking & Pastry Fundamentals (108 hours)

FDNT 676: Restaurant Economics & International Cuisine (70 hours)
